

#### FINANCIAL AID

Assistantships are awarded on a competitive basis and currently paying \$12,000 per academic year for a full-time assistantship of 20 hours per week. Some students may receive an out-of-state tuition remission (non-resident tuition charges waived), which are awarded based on merit. Remissions are competitive, with minimum 3.0 overall or 3.0 senior year GPA and a meritorious portfolio and application materials required. Additional financial support is also available through the Financial Aid Office.






